This reading plan arranges NT books in a **modified chronological order** that follows a basic historical timeline and groups significant authors together. For instance, Acts follows Luke since Luke wrote it as a sequel. James comes next since it was likely the first NT letter written, followed by the letters of Paul in the approx. order in which he wrote them. Other non-Paul letters follow, since they were likely written later, followed by all the writings of John – from his gospel, to his letters, to the Revelation.
